UAP ranks 5th among private universities in Bangladesh

According to a report published by the Spain-based university ranking website, <http://www.scimagir.com>, UAP ranks 5th among all the private universities in Bangladesh and 19th among all public and private universities in Bangladesh in 2021. According to the website, UAP's World Ranking is 836 and Asia Ranking is 458. The website recently published its ranking on the



basis of SCOPUS data of 4126 premier higher educational institutions worldwide. The University is also ranked 12th as an engineering university among all public and private universities of Bangladesh.

UAP Professor Dr. Tanveer Ferdous Saeed develops research on wastewater management using novel septic tank

Headed by Dr. Tanveer Ferdous Saeed, a Professor of the Department of Civil Engineering, University of Asia Pacific (UAP), a team comprising of UAP, Department of Public Health, WaterAid and United International University has recently published an extremely important research on wastewater treatment. The research was published in the prestigious Journal of 'Environmental Chemical Engineering (Elsevier Journal, IF: 4.3, Cite score 6.7).'

The team has developed a novel septic tank (bio-reactor septic tank) that could completely treat wastewater produced from domestic/commercial facilities. For this research, UAP has received BDT 10 lakh from WaterAid Bangladesh. Septic tank is an important wastewater treatment component that is relied on by approximately 40% population of Europe, Australia, and North America.

In the context of Bangladesh, Dhaka City and Puoroshovas are dependent on septic tanks. So this research would help solve the prolonged wastewater treatment problem. The proposed septic tank is easy to install, and existing septic tanks could be easily converted to the proposed systems without incurring major costs. WaterAid has already implemented this septic tank to treat wastewater of an educational institute in Mirpur.

Professor Dr. Tanveer Ferdous Saeed of Civil Engineering Department, University of Asia Pacific and an associate fellow of Bangladesh Academy of Sciences received a prestigious grant on 8th June 2021 from the Bangladesh Bureau of Educational Information and Statistics (BANBEIS), Ministry of Education, the Government of Bangladesh, to conduct rigorous research on landfill leachate treatment employing energy-producing wastewater treatment technologies.

Dr. Nehreen Majed, Associate Professor of the Civil Engineering Department is the co-investigator of the grant project. It is expected that the results of this research project will trigger the implementation of energy producing green constructed wetlands for leachate and other wastewater treatment of Bangladesh, which is a major environmental concern of the country. Prof. Saeed also gained funding for research from private sectors including WaterAid Bangladesh and the Institute of Energy, Environment, Research and Development (IEERD) of the University of Asia Pacific to conduct his research on wastewater treatment in Bangladesh.

Under the supervision of Prof. Saeed, Dr. Majed and Dr. Miah, natural floating constructed wetland technology is now being implemented by the WASA for increasing the treatment performance

of the Saidabad drinking water treatment plant. Prof. Saeed has received national and international awards, including the University Grants Commission Gold medal award twice for his outstanding contribution to research on waste water treatment. He has published many peer-reviewed journal articles on wastewater treatment in Bangladesh.
