His Excellency, Md. Zillur Rahman is the 19th President of People Republic of Bangladesh. He was born in a respectable family in Kishorganj on 19 March, 1929. He obtained Masters with Honors in History and LLB degrees from University of Dhaka. Md. Zillur Rahman played an active role in language movement in 1952 and was one of the veteran organizers of the Liberation War. In 1972 as a Member of the Constituent Assembly he actively took part in framing of the Constitution of Bangladesh.

Professor Dr. Abdul Matin Patwari, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of University of Asia Pacific and also the former Vice Chancellor of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology was born in a respectable family of Comilla on January 01, 1935. He completed B.S. in Electrical Engineering from University of Dhaka in 1956, and then he obtained M.S in Electrical Engineering from Texas A&M University, USA in 1961 and M.A. in Mathematics from University of California, USA in 1963. He pursued his Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering from University of Sheffield, UK in 1967. In his outstanding professional life he achieved several significant national and international affiliations. Very recently he has been elected as an Hon'ble Council Member of the Association of Commonwealth Universities.



Our Pro Vice-Chancellor

Professor Dr. M. R. Kabir, the Hon'ble Pro Vice Chancellor, also the Dean of Engineering Faculty of University of Asia Pacific was born on July 19, 1956. He obtained his Bachelor of Engineering degree from University of Roorkee, India in 1980, Master of Science from BUET in 1984. He pursued his Ph.D in Civil Engineering from Catholic University of Leuven, Belgium in 1993 with distinction. In his professional life, he has been successful both as a teacher and as an engineer.

Professor Dr. A. M. Patwari was elected as the Hon'ble Member of the Council of ACU. He is also the longest serving Vice Chancellor amongst all the Vice Chancellors in the history of Association of Commonwealth Universities. Prof. Dr. Abdul Matin Patwari was officially introduced at the conference by The ACU Secretary General. He was honored when he was invited to deliver the `Vote of Thanks' during the last session in ACU Conference 2011.

Higher education faces its most challenging environment for decades – and the need to learn from international practice is greater than ever before. The 2011 ACU Conference of Executive Heads was to challenge conventional wisdoms about future world markets, and focus was on the critical issues that Vice-chancellors needed to know in developing their future strategies. Set in the dynamic environment of Hong Kong – where the conference formed part of the centenary celebrations of the University of Hong Kong – this was one of the most significant conferences ever staged by the ACU.

Vice Chancellor and Pro Vice Chancellor of UAP delivered their precious speeches on that occasion.

Prof. Dr. A. M. Patwari attended the ACU Annual General Meeting and the New Strategic Plan. EEE Faculty Member of UAP Co-invents antenna design- Thesis receives 'Best Award' from BUET and published in MIT's Journal:






Picnic:
